- Develop social ties

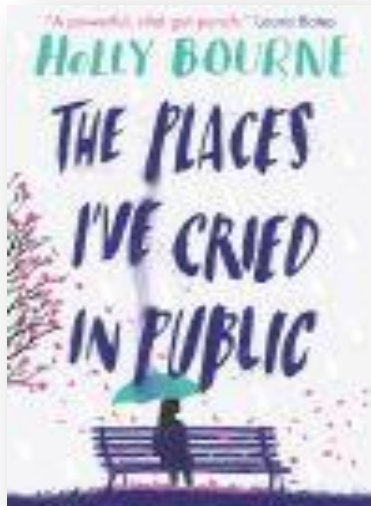
This book club is open to everyone who is fond of reading and of the English language.
